This is to inform you that the **Regional Advisory Committee (Service Tax)** for organised sector has been constituted for the calendar year 2004-05. **Calcutta Chamber of Commerce is one of the Members of the Committee.**

The members of the Committee will ordinarily meet once in a quarter. The function of the Committee will be purely advisory and is intended for resolving procedural difficulties of general nature.

The Governor has constituted the **Sales Tax Advisory Committee** at the State level for a period of one year from 1st October, 2004 to consider and advise on matters connected with the administration on Sales Tax Laws. **Calcutta Chamber of Commerce has been selected as member of this Committee.**

The Committee may consider and advise on any procedural or administrative matter of general interest to the trade, industry or consumers in relation to Sales Tax which may be referred to it by the Government or any member. The Committee shall meet at Kolkata at least once in six months to discuss the agenda to be prepared and circulated in advance by the Member-Secretary.

Members are requested to send their problems, views and suggestions on Service Tax as well as Sales Tax immediately so as to enable the Chamber to take up the matters in the meetings of the respective Committee.

RESOLUTION

The Governor has been pleased to reconstitute the Sales Tax Advisory Committee at the State level for a period of one year from the 1st October, 2004 to consider and advise on matters connected with the administration of Sales Tax Laws. The composition of the Committee will be as follows: —

- (1) Principal Secretary' to the Government of West Bengal, Finance Department —*Chairman*.
- (2) Special/Joint Secretary, Finance Department —*Member*.
- (3) Joint Registrar of Co-operative Societies (Consumers), West Bengal —*Member*.
- (4) Director of Industries, West Bengal —*Member*.
- (5) Director, Cottage and Small Scale Industries, West Bengal —*Member*.
- (6) One representative from each of the following Chambers of Commerce/Associations as *Member*:
 - (i) Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Kolkata
 - (ii) Indian Chamber of Commerce, Kolkata.
 - (iii) Bengal National Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Kolkata.
 - (iv) Bharat Chamber of Commerce, Kolkata.
 - (v) Oriental Chambers of Commerce, Kolkata.
 - (vi) Merchants' Chambers of Commerce, Kolkata.
 - (vii) Calcutta Chamber of Commerce, Kolkata.
 - (viii) Federation of Small and Medium Industries, West Bengal.
 - (ix) National Alliance of Young Entrepreneurs, Eastern Zone, Kolkata.
 - (x) Confederation of Engineering Industries, Eastern Region, Kolkata.
 - (xi) Commercial Taxes Bar Association, Kolkata.
 - (xii) Commercial Taxes Practitioners' Association, Kolkata.
 - (xiii) Federation of Associations of Cottage and Small Scale Industries, West Bengal.
 - (xiv) Federation of West Bengal Trade Associations.

- (7) Head of the Department of Economics, University of Kolkata –*Member*.
- (8) Commissioner, Commercial Taxes, West Bengal –*Member-Secretary*.

It shall be open to the Government, if they so choose, to ask any other person: –official or non-official –to attend the meeting of the Committee as special invitee.

2. The Committee may consider and advise on any procedural or administrative matter of general interest to the trade, industry or consumers in relation to Sales Tax which may be referred to it by the Government or any member. The Committee shall function in an advisory capacity and its recommendation will not be binding on the State Government.

3. The Committee shall meet at Kolkata at least once in six months to discuss the agenda to be prepared and circulated in advance by the Member-Secretary. The agenda of the meeting may include subjects referred to the Committee by the Government or proposed by any Member but a Member who proposes to include a subject in the agenda shall ordinarily give fifteen days' notice thereof to the Member-Secretary.

4. The headquarters of the Committee shall be in Kolkata.

5. The incidental expenditure in connection with the holding of the meeting of the Committee shall be met from the budget under the head "2040 –Taxes on Sales, Trades, etc".

ORDER

Ordered that the resolution be published in the "Kolkata Gazette" for general information.

Ordered also that copies of the resolution be sent to all Departments of this Government, Ministry of Finance, Department of Revenue, Government of India, New Delhi, the Principal Accountant General, West Bengal (A. & E.), Revenue Audit Wing of the Office of Accountant General-II, West Bengal, Nizam Palace, Kolkata, the Commissioner of Commercial Taxes, West Bengal, and the Secretaries of the Chambers of Commerce/Associations concerned and Head of the Department of Economics, University of Kolkata.




